Flight unable to land in BHC

BULLHEAD CITY - Two flights were diverted from the Laughlin/Bullhead International Airport Thursday due to weather.

Allegiant Air Flight 5213 from Lubbock, Texas, was diverted to Palm Springs, Calif., around 5 p.m., said David Gaines, airport manager.

"It's extremely rare for us (to divert flights)," Gaines said. "The weather is taking a toll."

Also Thursday, a Sun Country flight from Billings, Mont., was canceled.

A later Allegiant flight from Wichita, Kansas, was due to arrive in Laughlin/Bullhead at 8:09 p.m. As of 5 p.m., Gaines said he did not sure if the flight would be diverted.

The Allegiant flight that was diverted to Palm Springs was likely to try and land in Laughlin/Bullhead today.
